



# 01 The Pcloudy Dashboard




- **New default Dashboard:** Unified view of usage, key metrics, and live sessions.
- **Direct access to testing modules:** Jump instantly to Functional Testing and Performance Experience.
- **AI tools, one click away:** Access QLens, QPilot, AI Capabilities, and Desktop Assistant directly from the Dashboard.
- **30 day insights at a glance:** Sessions, automation runs, devices used, failures — with trend indicators.


**Why this matters:** You no longer need to navigate multiple sections to get a read on your team's testing activity. Everything important is visible the moment you log in.

## 02 Admin Dashboard Moved to Admin Space

### New UI




- **Admin Dashboard repositioned:** Now renamed to Admin Space and moved under the Admin section.
- **No functionality changes:** All existing admin capabilities remain exactly the same.
- **Cleaner navigation:** Admin tools are now logically grouped in one dedicated area, simplifying the main menu for general users.


**Why this matters:** Admin features are now contextually grouped where they belong — under Admin — reducing confusion for non-admin users and keeping the main menu clean.

## 03 Application Upload (My Data) Integrated into Device & Browser Page




- **'My Data' streamlined:** No longer a separate navigation item.
- **Single page workflow:** App upload and data management are now built directly into Device and Browser Connection pages.
- **Faster session setup:** Upload apps, manage data, and start testing all from one screen, eliminating navigation friction.


**Why this matters:** Fewer page switches means faster session starts. Your app upload and device selection are now part of the same flow, reducing setup time significantly.

## 04 Admin Section Upgraded to the Main Menu




- **Admin elevated to main menu:** Now a top level navigation item for faster access.
- **Single click control:** No more drilling through nested sub menus to reach admin tools.
- **Better discoverability:** Easier for new admins, faster for daily administrative tasks.


**Why this matters:** Admins can now reach any admin tool in one click from anywhere in the platform, making routine administrative tasks significantly faster.

## 05 Quick Actions — One-Click Username & Profile Copy




- **New Quick Actions panel:** Accessible from the top navigation bar on every screen.
- **One click copy:** Instantly copy your Username or full Profile details to the clipboard.
- **Built for speed:** Simplifies automation setup, API configuration, and secure credential sharing.


**Why this matters:** Copying your username or profile details used to require navigating away from your current work. Quick Actions brings this to you — no page change needed... These are useful infor needed frequently

## 6. Device Page — Card View Replaced with List View

### Old UI



### New UI




- **New list based layout:** Device page moves from cards to a structured, scrollable list for faster browsing.
- **Grouped by manufacturer:** Devices organized under Samsung, Apple, Google, OnePlus, making specific models easier to locate.
- **More visibility, less scrolling:** View more devices at once with key details like OS version, model, and availability shown inline.
- **Filters remain intact:** Fully compatible with all existing filter and sort options.


**Why this matters:** Finding the right device is now faster. Instead of clicking through cards, you can scan a structured list grouped by manufacturer and spot your target device in seconds.

## 07 Report Page — Simplified Navigation

- **Redesigned report navigation:** Fewer steps to reach the exact report you need.
- **Direct access from main menu:** Reduced intermediate pages and sub menu clicks.
- **Smarter filtering:** Prominent filters and categories help you narrow results faster without deep navigation.

**Why this matters:** Reviewing test results after a session used to require navigating multiple levels. The updated Report page gets you to the right report faster, keeping your debugging flow uninterrupted.
